MESD Migrant Education Program Summer School 2014

Dates: June 19-20 (Thursday and Friday): Staff in-service June 23 – July 11th: Student days (no school July 4) July 14 (Monday): Staff reporting day

The MESD Migrant Education Program will:

- Pay a Building Usage Fee of \$350.00
- Leave all classrooms the way they were left (vacuumed and cleaned)
- Take out garbage daily
- Provide their own paper for copy machine
- Provide principal with documentation to comply with the district animal policy
- Assist in moving small tables/desks and chairs for 100 students (KG, 1st and 2nd grades)

The District/Site will provide:

- Building access from 7:30 AM to 5:00 PM during the dates listed above
- Badges for summer staff coded for the hours/dates listed above (extend hours July 11 until 8:30 PM)
- A school/district summer contact person and phone number
- A copy of the building emergency plan
- Breakfast/Lunch through the summer feeding program
- Reserve the cafeteria and food support staff (paid by the MESD) for Friday, July 11 (5:00 7:00)
- Supply small tables/desks and chairs for 100 students (KG, 1st and 2nd grades)
- Access to building WIFI
